Thank you for your interest in Norwich Free Academy. As an independent secondary school, NFA welcomes private pay students to experience the extensive academic and co-curricular opportunities available to our students. We look forward to sharing our passion for NFA with you and your family.

The application process is as follows:

1. NFA is a regional day school. There are no boarding facilities.
2. Transportation is the responsibility of the family.
3. Annual tuition fees for students not residing in one of our partner districts are set in the spring. There may be additional costs for some specialized programs.
4. NFA has rolling admissions, but it is in your best interest for course selection opportunities to apply between January and March.
5. Complete the application for admission, and send it to Jessica Vocatura, Director of Guidance, along with your child's academic records (report card, transcript, test results, and Special Education IEP).
6. The Admissions Committee will review the application and records, and make an admissions decision.
7. Once a student is notified of acceptance, NFA's Finance Department will prepare a tuition contract.
8. Once a tuition contract is prepared, contact the registrar, Melody Pishka, (860-425-5605 or pishkam@nfaschool.org) to make an appointment to register. NFA will require complete academic and medical records. Course selection and placement testing will be discussed at this time.
9. The NFA Foundation, Inc., sponsors limited scholarship opportunities for tuition students. In the spring, we will provide information about the scholarship application process. Application deadline is April 1.
